1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Voter  
 3 Registration List Maintenance by the Secretary of State.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted  
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Secretary of State.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 24, 2016, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section twenty-three-a, article two, chapter three of this code, modified by the  
 3 Secretary of State to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and  
 4 refiled in the State Register on January 17, 2017, relating to the Secretary of State (Voter  
 5 Registration List Maintenance by the Secretary of State, [153 CSR 05](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Voter Registration List Maintenance by the Secretary of State.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
