### **House Bill 2363**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17E-1-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to commercial driver’s license; and requiring that a state employee with a commercial  
 3 driver’s license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical  
 4 waiver.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §17E-1-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and  
 2 reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 1. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.**

**§17E-1-18. Rule-making authority.**

1 The commissioner shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to carry out the ~~provision~~  
 2 provisions of this article: Provided, That the commissioner shall propose rules for legislative  
 3 approval in accordance with article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code that require a state  
 4 employee with a commercial driver’s license to have a current medical evaluation certification and  
 5 that the state employee is not entitled to a medical waiver from this requirement.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that a state employee with a commercial driver’s license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical waiver.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
