- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to voluntary remediation and redevelopment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section three, article twenty-two, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the
- 3 Department of Environmental Protection (Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment, 60 CSR
- 4 03), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment.
