### **Senate Bill 113**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule  
 3 relating to awarding of matching grants for local litter control programs.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted  
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL  
 PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2016, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section three, article fifteen-a, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the  
 3 Department of Environmental Protection (Awarding of Matching Grants for Local Litter Control  
 4 Programs, [33 CSR 41](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Awarding of Matching Grants for Local Litter Control Programs.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
