### **Senate Bill 157**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the  
3 procedure for fees in collections by charge, credit or debit card or by electronic payment.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted  
2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Treasurer's Office.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the  
2 authority of section six, article three-a, chapter twelve of this code, modified by the Treasurer's  
3 Office to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the  
4 State Register on October 21, 2016, relating to the Treasurer's Office (Procedure for Fees in  
5 Collections by Charge, Credit or Debit Card or by Electronic Payment, [112 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Procedure for Fees in Collections by Charge, Credit or Debit Card or by Electronic Payment.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
