- 1 AN ACT to repeal §16-28-1, §16-28-2, §16-28-3, §16-28-4, §16-28-5, §16-28-6, §16-28-7, §16-28-8, §16-28-9 and §16-28-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 3 to repealing the article on providing assistance to Korea and Vietnam veterans exposed
- 4 to certain chemical defoliants or herbicides or other causative agents, including Agent
- 5 Orange.

- §1. Repeal of article concerning assistance to Korea and Vietnam veterans exposed to certain chemical defoliants or herbicides or other causative agents, including Agent Orange.
- 1 That §16-28-1, §16-28-2, §16-28-3, §16-28-4, §16-28-5, §16-28-6, §16-28-7, §16-28-8,
- 2 §16-28-9 and §16-28-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, are hereby repealed.
