A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §51-1-22, relating to establishing a new special revenue fund, designated the
Court Advanced Technology Subscription Fund, for the purpose of collecting and remitting
moneys to the State Treasury for the use of certain advanced technology systems
provided by the Supreme Court of Appeals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §51-1-22, to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 1. SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS.

#### §51-1-22. Court Advanced Technology Subscription Fund created.

- (a) There is created within the State Treasury a special revenue fund designated the Court
   Advanced Technology Subscription Fund to be administered by the West Virginia Supreme Court
   of Appeals.
- (b) The fund shall consist of moneys received from subscribers using the court's advanced
   technology systems including, but not limited to, the e-filing system and the Unified Judicial
   Application Information System.
  - (c) All moneys deposited into the State Treasury and credited to the Court Advanced

    Technology Subscription Fund shall be used to pay the costs associated with maintaining and

    administering the court's advanced technology systems.
  - (d) All moneys collected by the administrator of the Supreme Court of Appeals for the use of the court's advanced technology shall be deposited into the Court Advanced Technology Subscription Fund. Expenditures from the fund shall be for the purposes set forth in subsection (c) of this section and are not authorized from collections but are to be made only in accordance with appropriation by the Legislature in accordance with article three, chapter twelve of this code and upon fulfillment of the requirements of article two, chapter eleven-b of this code: *Provided*,

- 16 That for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, expenditures are authorized from collections rather
- 17 than pursuant to appropriation by the Legislature.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a new special revenue fund to collect and remit moneys to the Court Advanced Technology Subscription Fund in the State Treasury for the use of certain advanced technology provided by the judiciary.
