## Senate Bill 136

BY SENATORS TRUMP AND RUCKER

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §60-4-3c, relating to declaring that the mere addition of a mini-distillery does
- 3 not change the nature or use of agricultural property for building code and property tax
- 4 classification purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### **ARTICLE 4. LICENSES.**

#### §60-4-3c. Mini-distillery effect on building code and property tax classification.

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, the mere addition of a mini-
- 2 distillery licensed under this article does not change the nature or use of property that otherwise
- 3 gualifies as agricultural for building code and property tax classification purposes.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that the mere addition of a mini-distillery does not change the nature or use of agricultural property for building code and property tax classification purposes.
