## Senate Bill 161

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to West Virginia surface mining reclamation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2017, authorized under the authority of §22-3-13 of this code, modified by the Department of Environmental Protection to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 5, 2017, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (West Virginia surface mining reclamation, 38 CSR 2), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to West Virginia surface mining reclamation.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
