1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
 3 relating to voluntary remediation and redevelopment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 11, 2017, authorized under the
 2 authority of §22-22-3 of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection
 3 (voluntary remediation and redevelopment, [60 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to voluntary remediation and redevelopment.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
