- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to child care centers licensing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2017, authorized under the authority of §49-2-121 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
- 4 Register on October 4, 2017, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (child
- 5 care centers licensing, 78 CSR 1), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to child care centers licensing.
