1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to
 3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to protocol for law enforcement response to domestic
 4 violence.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND
 PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Governor’s Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the
 2 authority of §48-27-1102 of this code, modified by the Governor’s Committee on Crime,
 3 Delinquency and Correction to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 14, 2017, relating to the Governor’s
 5 Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction (protocol for law enforcement response to
 6 domestic violence, [149 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor’s Committee on Crime,
 Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to protocol for law
 enforcement response to domestic violence.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
