1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to requirements for licensure as a psychologist and/or a school psychologist.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Examiners of Psychologists.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-21-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to meet  
3 the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register  
4 on December 15, 2017, relating to the Board of Examiners of Psychologists (requirements for  
5 licensure as a psychologist and/or a school psychologist, [17 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for licensure as a psychologist and/or a school psychologist.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
