1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to vote by  
3 mail pilot project phase 2: voting by mail.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Secretary of State.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the  
2 authority of §3-3A-3 of this code, relating to the Secretary of State (vote by mail pilot project phase  
3 2: voting by mail, [153 CSR 39](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to vote by mail pilot project phase 2: voting by mail.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
