A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to authorizing the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
wildlife disease management.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-10-1. Division of Natural Resources.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the 2 authority of §20-1-7 of this code, modified by the Division of Natural Resources to meet the 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on 4 December 11, 2017, relating to the Division of Natural Resources (wildlife disease management, 5 58 CSR 69), is authorized with the amendments set forth below: 6 On page 3, subsection 5.1 to read as follows: 7 5.1. No person shall possess or use any substance or material that contains or purports 8 to contain excretions collected from cervids including feces, blood, gland oil and other bodily

9 fluids, but excluding urine, for the purposes of taking or attempting to take, attracting, or scouting

10 any wild animal in West Virginia.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to wildlife disease management.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
