1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2	designated §10-1-24, relating to establishing a Library Facilities Improvement Fund that
3	will serve to support library facilities construction, maintenance, and improvement projects;
4	setting forth general structure of fund and distribution of funds; and providing for
5	rulemaking.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

§10-1-24. Library Facilities Improvement Fund.

- 1 (a) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund known as the "Library Facilities
- 2 Fund". The fund shall be administered by the West Virginia Library Commission and used to
- 3 effectuate the purposes of this section.
- 4 (b) The fund consists of moneys received from the following sources:
- 5 (1) All appropriations provided by the Legislature to support library facilities improvements:
- 6 (2) Any moneys available from external sources;
- 7 (3) Repayment of loans made by the West Virginia Library Commission pursuant to this
- 8 section; and
- 9 (4) All interest and other income earned from investment of moneys in the fund.
- 10 (c) The West Virginia Library Commission shall use moneys in the fund to support public
- 11 library facilities construction, renovation, maintenance, and improvement projects. Projects shall
- 12 <u>be evaluated on a competitive basis.</u>
- 13 (1) The West Virginia Library Commission may use a portion of the moneys in the fund to
- 14 provide loans to public libraries to support energy savings and critical maintenance projects.
- 15 (2) With the exception of loans under this section, all moneys expended from the funds
- 16 shall be matched on at least a dollar-for-dollar basis from funds obtained from other sources.
- 17 (d) The West Virginia Library Commission shall propose a rule for legislative approval in
- 18 accordance with §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code to implement the provisions of this section. The

- 19 rule shall contain at least the following:
- 20 (1) A process for submitting and reviewing proposals;
- 21 (2) The content of proposals;
- 22 (3) Criteria for evaluating proposals; and
- 23 (4) Other provisions the West Virginia Library Commission considers necessary to
- 24 administer the program in accordance with this section.
- 25 (e) Any balance, including accrued interest and any other returns, in the Library Facilities
- 26 Improvement Fund at the end of each fiscal year do not expire to the General Revenue Fund but
- 27 remain in the fund and be expended for the purposes provided by this section.
- 28 (f) The West Virginia Library Commission may use up to four percent of the amount
- 29 provided to the fund for administrative expenses.
- 30 (g) Fund balances may be invested with the state's Consolidated Investment Fund.
- 31 Earnings on the investments shall be used solely for the purposes defined in subsections (c) and
- 32 (e) of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a Library Facilities Improvement Fund that will serve to support library facilities construction, maintenance, and improvement projects; and set forth general structure of fund and distribution of funds; and providing for rulemaking.
