INTRODUCED H.B.

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §8-29-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- to requiring regional airport authority board members to include persons of area expertise.
 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
- That §8-29-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 29. INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS - REGIONAL AIRPORTS.

§8-29-6. Qualification of members.

- 1 (a) All members of the board of each authority shall be residents of the municipality or
- 2 county which said the members represent.
- 3 (b) The members of the airport authority must fairly represent different areas of interest,
- 4 knowledge and expertise. The members of the authority shall include at least:
- 5 (1) One active commercial pilot holding at least a commercial pilot's license with related
- 6 <u>experience current with the Federal Aviation Administration;</u>
- 7 (2) One member with aircraft maintenance experience holding at least an airframe and
- 8 power plant license issued by and current with the Federal Aviation Administration; and
- 9 (3) One member with experience, knowledge and expertise in airport management.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require regional airport authority board members to include persons of area expertise.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
