1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to controlled
3 substances monitoring program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 19, 2017, authorized under
2 the authority of §60A-9-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections
3 of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November
4 7, 2017, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (controlled substances monitoring program, [15 CSR](#)
5 [8](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to controlled substances monitoring program.
