- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
- 3 rule relating to emergency medical services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the authority of §16-4C-6 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 11, 2017, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (emergency medical services, 64 CSR 48), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to emergency medical services.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
