Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 20. WOMEN'S COMMISSION.

§29-20-1. Termination of the Women's Commission.

- 1 The Women's Commission is declared to be terminated and shall not exist after June 30,
- 2 2019. Pursuant to the provisions of §4-10-12 and §4-10-13 of this code, the commission shall
- 3 wind up its affairs, arrange for the disposition of its funds, assets, equipment and records, and
- 4 cease all activities before July 1, 2019.
