1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §48-22-804, relating to nullifying certain adoption orders, to read as follows:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 22. ADOPTION.**

#### §48-22-804. Annulment of adoption by adoptee.

- Any adult resident who has been previously adopted by order of a West Virginia court may

  petition a circuit court for a court order annulling the adoption. Upon granting the petition by the

  court, all legal rights and privileges granted pursuant to state law by the adoption are null and
- 4 void. The court, upon request of the petitioner, as part of any such order, may change the name
- 5 of the petitioner, if the petitioner has the legal surname of the adopted parent.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow adult adoptees who are residents of the state to nullify adoption orders of state courts.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
