A BILL to authorize the expenditure of surplus funds by the Wyoming County Commission.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

WYOMING COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE K-9 UNIT.

§1. County commission authorized to create special fund for the Wyoming County

Sheriff's Department for a K-9 unit to assist with drug searches.

- 1 The County Commission of Wyoming County is hereby authorized and empowered to use
- 2 any unexpended sums and surpluses, presently or hereafter existing, in the General Fund or in
- 3 any special fund for the Wyoming County Sheriff's Department to establish a K-9 Unit to assist
- 4 with drug searches.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Wyoming County Commission to spend surplus funds to establish a K-9 Unit for drug searches.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
