- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 industrial hemp.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §19-12E-7 of this code, modified by the Commissioner of Agriculture to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 December 11, 2018, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (industrial hemp, 61 CSR 29), is
- 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to industrial hemp.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
