### **Senate Bill 197**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 farmers markets.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §19-35-4 and 5 of this code, modified by the Commissioner of Agriculture to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 November 26, 2018, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (farmers markets, [61 CSR 38](#)),  
 5 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to farmers markets.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
