1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to rules and regulations governing the safety of those employed in and around
 4 surface mines in West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2018, authorized under the
 2 authority of §22A-1-38 of this code, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training
 3 (rules and regulations governing the safety of those employed in and around surface mines in
 4 West Virginia, [56 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rules and regulations governing the safety of those employed in and around surface mines in West Virginia.
