A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
rule relating to rules and regulations governing the submission and approval of a
comprehensive mine safety program for coal mining operations in the State of West
Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.
