## **Senate Bill 569**

BY SENATORS CARMICHAEL (MR. PRESIDENT) AND PREZIOSO

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
 2 designated §5A-3-10f, relating to interagency procurement of commodities and services;  
 3 and authorizing state spending units to enter into contracts for commodities and services  
 4 with other state spending units.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 3. PURCHASING DIVISION.**

**§5A-3-10f. Interagency procurement for commodities and services.**

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of this code to the contrary, state spending units may enter  
 2 into contracts for the procurement of commodities and services that would otherwise be subject  
 3 to §5A-3-10 or §5A-3-10b of this code with another state spending unit: *Provided*, That the  
 4 commodities or services procured be provided by the spending unit and may not be subcontracted  
 5 to a third party.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize state spending units to enter into contracts for commodities and services with other state spending units.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
