- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §5A-3-10f, relating to interagency procurement of commodities and services;
- 3 and authorizing state spending units to enter into contracts for commodities and services
- 4 with other state spending units.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. PURCHASING DIVISION.

§5A-3-10f. Interagency procurement for commodities and services.

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of this code to the contrary, state spending units may enter
- 2 into contracts for the procurement of commodities and services that would otherwise be subject
- 3 to §5A-3-10 or §5A-3-10b of this code with another state spending unit: Provided, That the
- 4 commodities or services procured be provided by the spending unit and may not be subcontracted
- 5 to a third party.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize state spending units to enter into contracts for commodities and services with other state spending units.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
