1 A BILL supplementing and amending by increasing existing items of appropriation of public
 2 moneys out of the Treasury in the State Fund, General Revenue, to the Department of
 3 Health and Human Resources, Division of Health – Central Office, fund 0407, fiscal year
 4 2019, organization 0506, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal
 5 year ending June 30, 2019.

6 Whereas, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget document,
 7 dated January 9, 2019, which included a Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting
 8 forth therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2018, and further included a revised estimate of
 9 revenues for the fiscal year 2019, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular
 10 appropriations for the fiscal year 2019; and

11 Whereas, It appears from the Executive Budget document, Statement of the State Fund,
 12 General Revenue, there remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is
 13 available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019; therefore

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, to fund 0407, fiscal
 16 year 2019, organization 0506, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of
 17 appropriation as follows:
