- 1 AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- designated §48-2-406, relating to authorizing certain members of the federal judiciary to
- 3 perform marriages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. MARRIAGES.

PART IV. MARRIAGE CEREMONY.

§48-2-406. Federal judges authorized to perform marriages.

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, active and senior status judges
- 2 appointed under Article III of the United States Constitution and federal magistrate-judges, who
- 3 are residents of this state, are authorized to perform marriages in any county of this state.
