- 20 (b) It is unlawful for any <u>physician or</u> psychotherapist, or any person who fraudulently
- 21 represents himself or herself as a physician or psychotherapist, to engage in sexual contact or
- sexual intercourse with a client or patient by means of therapeutic deception.
- 23 (c) For purposes of this section, consent of the patient or client is not a defense, regardless
- 24 of the age of the patient or client.
- 25 (d) Any person who violates subsection (b) of this section is guilty of a felony and, upon
- 26 conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned in a state correctional
- 27 facility for not less than one year nor more than five years, or both fined and imprisoned.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to add medical doctors and doctors of osteopathy to the category of medical professionals who are subject to the prohibition against therapeutic deception.
