- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §60-3A-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to permitting retail liquor licensees to sell alcoholic beverages from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. on
- 3 Sundays.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3A. SALES BY RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSEES.

§60-3A-18. Days and hours retail licensees may sell liquor.

- 1 Retail licensees may not sell liquor on Sundays and Christmas day, before 10 a.m. or after
- 2 <u>10 p.m. on Sundays</u> or between the hours of 12 midnight and eight o'clock a.m., except that wine
- 3 and fortified wines may be sold on those days and at such times as authorized in §60-8-34 of this
- 4 code.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit retail sale of alcoholic beverages on Sundays from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
