1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §9-5-27, relating to requiring recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
 3 Program be issued a photo identification card; establishing criminal penalties for misuse;
 4 and requires rule-making.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

§9-5-27. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program photo identification card; penalties; rule-making.

1 (a) All Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients shall be issued an
 2 identification card with his or her photograph on it that must be used at all times when making
 3 purchases covered or permitted by the program. Anyone using or attempting to use a SNAP card
 4 that has not been issued to him or her is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be
 5 confined in jail for not more than 15 days, fined not more than \$500, or both confined and fined.

6 (b) Anyone who knowingly permits another person to improperly use his or her SNAP card
 7 is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be confined in jail for not more than 15
 8 days, fined not more than \$500, or both confined and fined.

9 (c) The secretary shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the
 10 provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code to implement this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program be issued a photo identification card that must be used when making program purchases. The bill establishes penalties for misuse. The bill also requires rule-making.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
