- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
- 2 designated §15-15-1, relating to requiring lighted exit signs in buildings where members
- 3 of the public may frequent.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 15. LIGHTED EXIT SIGNS REQUIRED.

§15-15-1. Lighted exit signs required in certain buildings.

- 1 All buildings that receive public funding to which members of the public have access are
- 2 required to have lighted exit signs with emergency power backup so that the members of the
- 3 public can see where they can safely exit the building in cases power failure, fire or other
- 4 <u>emergency.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require lighted exit signs with emergency power backup in all building to which the public has access.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
