- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §18-4-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to placing a limit on the salary of a county superintendent of schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.

§18-4-4. Compensation.

- 1 On or before June 1 of the year in which the superintendent is appointed, the board shall
- 2 fix the annual salary of the superintendent for the period of appointment for the term beginning on
- 3 the following July 1. The board shall pay the salary from the general current expense fund of the
- 4 district. <u>The salary of any superintendent may not exceed \$130,000.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to cap the salary of a county superintendent of schools at \$130,000.
