- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia,1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
- 2 designated §16-2A-1, relating to requiring abortions to be performed by a licensed
- 3 physician.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2A. PERFORMANCE OF ABORTIONS LIMITED.

§16-2A-1. Performance of abortions by physicians.

- 1 <u>Any abortion performed must be performed by a licensed physician in good standing in</u>
- 2 this state. Nothing in this section requires or endorses the performance of abortions.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that any abortion must be performed by a licensed physician.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
