1 A BILL to amend and reenact §11-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating 2

to removing the residency requirements for hiring deputy assessors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. ASSESSORS.

§11-2-3. Selection of deputy assessors.

1	The deputy assessors, including the transfer and office deputies, shall be residents and
2	voters in the county: Provided, That a deputy assessor whose primary responsibility is that of
3	updating the assessor's maps may be a resident and voter of a contiguous county of this state.
4	The deputy assessors shall be appointed by the assessor with the advice and consent of the
5	county commission, and may be removed at any time in the discretion of the assessor. Vacancies
6	occurring from any cause in the office of any deputy assessor shall be filled by the assessors.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to remove the residency requirements for hiring deputy assessors.
