1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §48-5-210, relating to requiring receipt of the reason, order, notice, or other
 3 information relating to a person being required to undergo a psychological or mental health
 4 evaluation during divorce and child custody proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. DIVORCE.

§48-5-210. Psychological evaluation.

1 No person shall be required to undergo a psychological or mental health evaluation
 2 without receiving a copy of the reason, order, notice, or other information relating to requiring a
 3 person to undergo a psychological or mental health evaluation. This section applies to the
 4 provisions in this article and the provisions in §48-9-101 et seq of this code.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require receipt of the reason, order, notice, or other information relating to a person being required to undergo a psychological or mental health evaluation during divorce and child custody proceedings.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
