1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §60-4-3c, relating to allowing the same business owner to brew and sell beer
 3 to also distill and sell liquor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. LICENSES.

§60-4-3c. Beer and liquor licenses may be held by the same person.

1 Any person who is licensed to manufacture and sell liquor under the provisions of §60-4-
 2 3a of this code may also be licensed to brew and sell beer under the provisions of §11-16-1 et
 3 seq. of this code.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow the same business owner to brew and sell beer to also distill and sell liquor.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
