designated §18-5-15e, relating to requiring schools to offer elective vocational courses in

3 middle schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-5-15e. Elective vocational courses for middle schools.

- 1 <u>County boards of education shall provide elective vocational courses for middle schools</u>
- 2 by the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year. The courses provided shall follow rules to be
- 3 <u>developed by the State Board of Education and may include such courses as home economics,</u>
- 4 industrial arts, and agriculture.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require schools to offer elective vocational courses in middle schools.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
