1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
 3 to application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Chiropractic Examiners.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 10, 2019, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 October 4, 2019, relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners (application for waiver of initial  
 5 licensing fees for certain individuals, [4 CSR 07](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
