- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating
- 3 to waiver of initial licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS**

#### TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2019, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 November 14, 2019, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (waiver of initial licensing fees
- 5 for certain initial licensure applicants, 24 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver of initial licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
