- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Sanitarians to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver
- 3 of initial application fees and criteria for initial licensure.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Sanitarians.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 1, 2019, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-17-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Sanitarians to meet the objections of
- 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on January 7,
- 4 2020, relating to the Board of Sanitarians (waiver of initial application fees and criteria for initial
- 5 licensure, 20 CSR 05), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Sanitarians to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver of initial application fees and criteria for initial licensure.
