1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 schedule of fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Veterinary Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 9, 2019, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-10-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Veterinary Medicine to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 January 2, 2020, relating to the Board of Veterinary Medicine (schedule of fees, [26 CSR 06](#)), is
 5 authorized with the amendments set forth below:

6 On page 2, Section 3.6, by striking out “\$100.00” and inserting in lieu thereof “\$10.00”;

7 On page 2, Section 3.7, following the word “Veterinary”, by inserting the word
 8 “Technician”;

9 On page 2, Section 3.7, by striking out “\$80.00” and inserting in lieu thereof “\$5.00”;

10 On page 2, Section 3.8, by striking out “\$25.00” and inserting in lieu thereof “\$2.00”;

11 On page 2, Section 3.9, following the word “inactive”, by striking out the word “license”
 12 and inserting in lieu thereof the word “registration”;

13 And,

14 On page 2, Section 3.9, by striking out “\$80.00” and inserting in lieu thereof “\$6.00”.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Veterinary Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to schedule of fees.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
