designated §2-1-3, relating to clarifying the American Law Institute's Restatements of Law

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. COMMON LAW.

§2-1-3. Clarifying that The American Law Institute Restatements of the Law are not controlling.

- 1 <u>In any action governed by the laws of this state concerning rights and obligations under</u>
- 2 the law, The American Law Institute's Restatements of the Law are not controlling.
