## ARTICLE 1. COMMON LAW.

## §2-1-3. Clarifying that Restatements of the Law and other treatises are not controlling authority.

- 1 <u>In any action governed by the laws of this state concerning rights and obligations under</u>
- 2 the law, the Restatements of the Law and other legal treatises are not controlling authority.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify that the Restatements of Law are not controlling authority.
