1 AN ACT expiring funds to the unappropriated surplus balance in the State Fund, General
2 Revenue, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, in the amount of \$4,500,000 from the
3 balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State Excess Lottery
4 Revenue Fund, and making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the
5 Treasury from the unappropriated surplus balance in the State Fund, General Revenue,
6 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to the Department of Veterans' Assistance –
7 Department of Veterans' Assistance, fund 0456, fiscal year 2020, organization 0613.

8 Whereas, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature on
9 January 8, 2020, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth therein
10 the cash balance as of July 1, 2019, and further included the estimate of revenue for the fiscal
11 year 2020, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus appropriations for
12 the fiscal year 2020, and further included recommended expirations to the unappropriated surplus
13 balance of the State Fund, General Revenue; and

14 Whereas, It appears from the Governor's statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue
15 Fund, there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for
16 expiration during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020; and

17 Whereas, It appears from the Governor's statement of the State Fund, General Revenue,
18 and this legislation, there now remains an unappropriated surplus balance in the Treasury which
19 is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the balance of the funds remaining as an unappropriated balance for the fiscal year
2 ending June 30, 2020, in the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund be decreased by expiring the
3 amount of \$4,500,000 to the unappropriated surplus balance of the State Fund, General Revenue
4 to be available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

5 And, That the total appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to fund 0226,
6 fiscal year 2020, organization 0221, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing
7 item appropriation as follows:
