- 1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §60-3A-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
- 2 relating to altering the time frame which retail liquor licensees may sell liquors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3A. SALES BY RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSEES.

§60-3A-18. Days and hours retail licensees may sell liquor.

- 1 Retail licensees may not sell liquor on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or between the
- 2 hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., except that wine and fortified wines may be sold on those days
- 3 and at such times as authorized in §60-8-34 of this code.
