1 A BILL to amend §1-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 reapportionment of the counties of this state into congressional districts following the 2020
 3 decennial census.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1-2-3. Congressional districts.

4 The number of members to which the state is entitled in the House of Representatives of
 5 the Congress of the United States are apportioned among the counties of the state, arranged into
 6 ~~three~~ two congressional districts, numbered as follows:
