## House Bill 2028

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §60A-9-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to exempting a veterinarian from the requirements of controlled substance monitoring.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## §60A-9-2. Establishment of program; purpose.

1 There is hereby established <u>continued</u> a West Virginia controlled substances monitoring

2 act the purpose of which is to require the recordation and retention in a single repository of

3 information regarding the prescribing, dispensing and consumption of certain controlled

4 substances. <u>A veterinarian is exempt from the requirements of this article.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to is exempt a veterinarian from the requirements of controlled substance monitoring.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
